A Unique Expression of Church

What makes the Evangelical Covenant Church (ECC), the denomination Lakeside is affiliated with, unique and stands out from other churches is the fact that while we strongly affirm the clear teaching of the Bible, it allows followers of Jesus the personal freedom to have varying interpretations on theological issues that are not clearly presented in Scripture. You might hear the phrase around Lakeside, "major on the majors and minor on the minors." Another way to say this is; In essentials—unity, in nonessentials—liberty and in all things charity.

The ECC is guided by six affirmations: 1)The centrality of the word of God, 2) the necessity of the new birth, 3) a commitment to the whole mission of the Church, 4) the Church as a fellowship of believers, 5) a conscious dependence on the Holy Spirit, 6) the reality of freedom in Christ.
